Record request A.

Record request B.

Obtaining permission to enter and inspect a property is required by Wis Stat 66.0119. I request all documentation that such permission was obtained by the Village of Germantown or it agents between March 1, 2007 and July 18, 2008 where the permission obtained and document was obtained as part of a property assessment for tax purposes.

I am willing to pay any reasonable fee for copying of the requested records. If the estimated cost for copying these records exceeds \$50, please present me with a written itemization of the estimated cost.

Severability – Requests

These two requests are severable and are included in a single correspondence for administrative simplicity and thematic similarity. A delay in the production of records responsive to one request will not delay, hinder, or otherwise affect the delivery of records responsive to the other request.

Severability – Record Production

Each of these two open records requests cover several records. The production of records responsive to a particular request is also severable. The delay in the production of some records responsive to a request will not delay, hinder or otherwise affect the production of other records responsive to the request.
